The stories behind the iconic records and recordings, the untimely deaths, landmark live performances, on screen incidents and all of the most outrageous moments are recounted in this captivating, comprehensive overview of the greatest musical form of the twentieth century. In 1967, Rolling Stone magazine founder Jann Wenner asked Baron Wolman to be his first chief photographer and over the next several years Baron gained unprecedented access to some of the greatest artists of the day including The Grateful Dead, The Who, Led Zeppelin, Pink Floyd, George Harrison, The Rolling Stones, Joni Mitchell, Eric Clapton, Frank Zappa, and of course, the legendary limi Hendrix. On four separate occasions in 1968 and 1970 in San Francisco and New York City, Baron captured Hendrix with "Experience" bass player Noel Redding and drummer Mitch Mitchell both on stage, and alone in private settings. For the first time in history, Wolman has opened his Hendrix archive, and has selected the best shots for full page reproduction, 422 in total, most published for the first time. The book includes also images of the vintage contact sheets and 1968 private photo log book.





The book details why Capitol Records turned down the Beatles four times before finally agreeing to release their records, and tells the stories of two small companies, Vee-Jay and Swan, who issued the group's records without success in 1963. It details the American media coverage of the Beatles in late 1963, when Beatlemania was viewed as a curious fad happening in England that could never catch on in the United States.



Nick Mason is the well-known drummer of Pink Floyd, which was formed in 1965. After a year in the London 'underground' experimenting with revolutionary techniques such as lights that matched their music, the band released their first single in 1966. Their breakthrough album, The Dark Side of the Moon, was released in 1973 and stayed in the charts until 1982, the longest a record has ever been continuously in the charts, and becoming one of the best-selling albums of all time. In 1979, The Wall went to #I in almost every country in the world. The movie version starring Bob Geldof was released in 1982.


